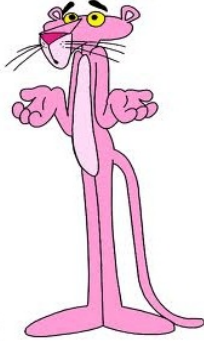
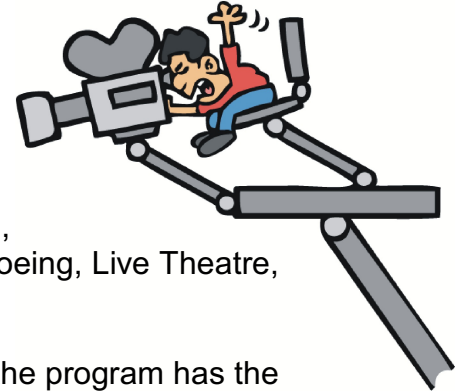




The Drama-Play Connection
